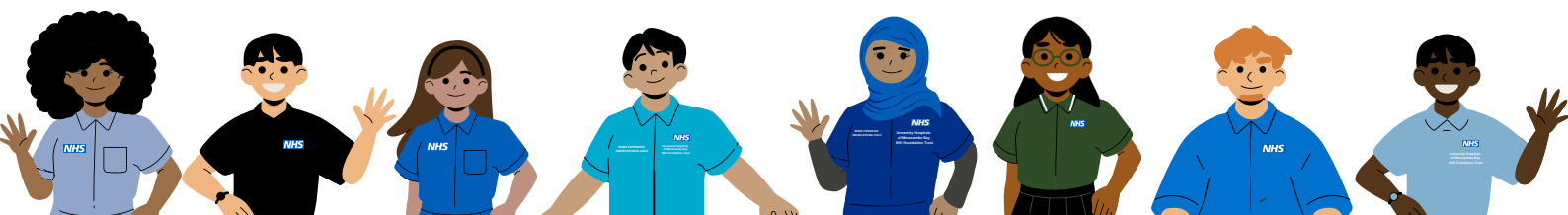
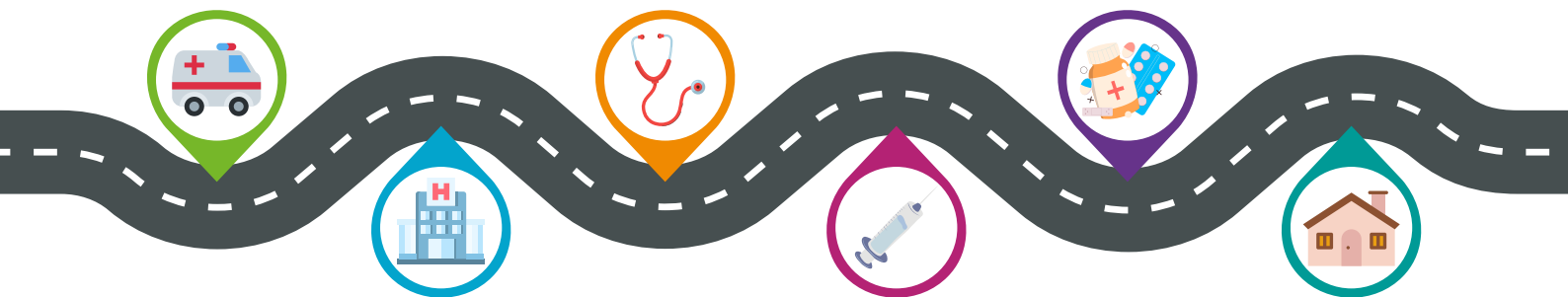

Introduction

The UHMBT Careers & Apprenticeships Team are pleased to bring you details of our current offer to primary schools.

We are here to engage and inspire our future workforce by providing immersive and interactive workshops for KS1, LKS2 and UKS2.

The Careers & Apprenticeship Team within University Hospitals of Morecambe Bay NHS Foundation Trust (UHMBT) has developed resources for all ages within the Primary School setting, which enable young learners to understand the range of roles and careers that are available within the Health & Care system; not just doctors and nurses!

The resources have been co-developed by an experienced Primary School teacher and those who have worked within education. The Workshops are interactive and fun and can be linked to many areas of the PSCHÉ curriculum; we should add that there is no cost to the school for any of this provision; it's all free and delivered by the UHMBT Careers & Apprenticeships Team.



Our Offers

Early Years & Key Stage 1

For EYFS we have a 30-45 minute session that looks at 'People who help us' with particular focus on hospitals.

The session includes discussion around how it feels to be poorly, where we go for help, who we see and what to expect if you have to stay in hospital overnight.

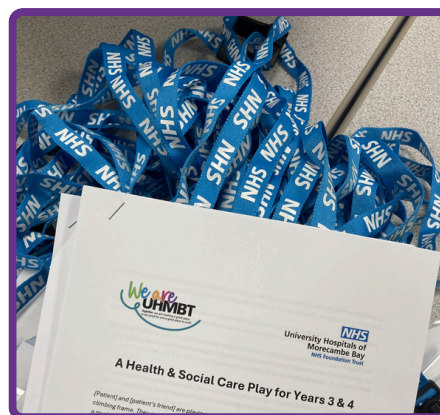
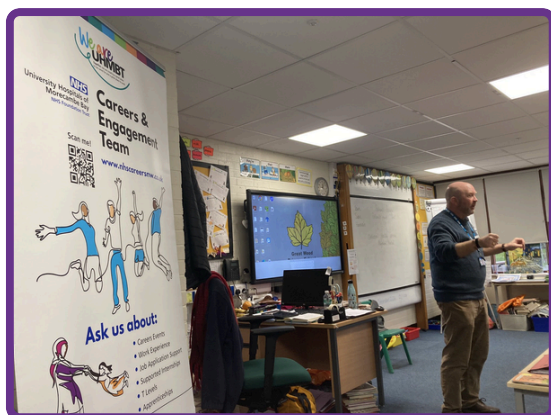
This session has been developed with a professional Play Specialist from the Trust.



Health & Social Care Play - LKS2

The Workshop for learners in Years 3 & 4 takes the form of a scripted play that the class perform, with the use of props which we provide. The play follows the journey of a young person who has had an accident at a playground and highlights many of the professionals involved in their care.

There are 27 'speaking parts', so usually all the children in the class have a role, although there are also two roles which do not involve any dialogue. The Workshop is designed to be delivered in an hour-long session and is best delivered to one class at a time.

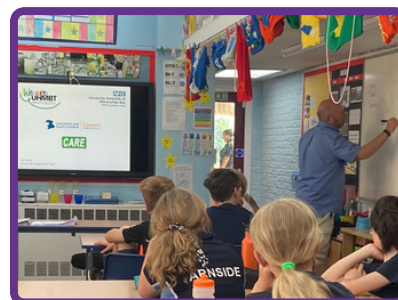
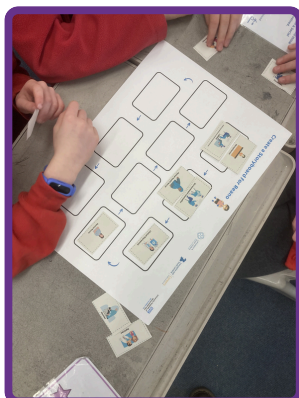
Holistic Person Journey UKS2

For learners in Years 5 & 6, we have the Holistic Person Journey Workshop. This Workshop introduces the range of roles within the NHS and Social Care, by looking at the journey of a patient through the system and highlights key professionals involved in their care.

If extended to a 2-hour session, the learners then look at another scenario and work together to map out this new journey, based on the learning from the previous hour.

We also look at pay scales of roles and qualifications required to undertake a range of career pathways.

The maximum class size for this Workshop is around 30 and it can be delivered in either a 1 or 2 hour session.
